



Standard Terms and Conditions of Purchase

Conformity of goods supplied/Machinery Directive (CE)

1. The Contractor shall be obliged to ensure that the goods supplied meet the requirements for manufacture, marketing and use of all applicable product-specific European and compulsory national regulations and harmonized standards. That also includes any necessary registration of the goods supplied and/or their component parts. In particular, the Contractor shall be obliged to ensure conformity of the supplied goods with the relevant applicable harmonization legislation regulations of the European Union and the national implementations thereof as listed in the currently applicable version of Appendix I of Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 in each case.
2. The Contractor shall send the Client and the regulatory authorities concerned the relevant documentation in that regard and shall accept any and all liability on the basis of those directives and standards which falls within the Contractor's area of responsibility.
3. In particular, the Contractor shall attach the CE mark to and supply operating instructions for machines covered by Regulation 9 of the *Produktsicherheitsgesetz* (German Product Safety Act, Machinery Regulations) and/or electrical equipment covered by the Low Voltage Directive. The Contractor shall hand the declaration of conformity and the operating instructions to the Client in text form. Incomplete machines are to be supplied to the Client with a declaration of incorporation and detailed installation/operating instructions that take account of the requirements of the Machinery Regulations.

UK product safety and metrology guidance for the market of Great Britain/Supply of Machinery (Safety) Regulations 2008

1. The Contractor shall be obliged to ensure that the goods supplied meet the requirements of the UK legislation especially but not exclusively the currently applicable version of the UK Product Safety and Metrology etc. (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 ("UK Product Safety and Metrology Regulations 2019") at the time in question including the currently applicable version at the time in question of all product safety requirements specified therein or amended thereby. The Contractor shall send the Client and the regulatory authorities the relevant documentation in that regard and shall accept any and all liability on the basis of those standards. In particular, the Contractor shall be obliged – where it is a statutory requirement – to label the supplied goods with the relevant UK Conformity Assessed ("UKCA") mark with the involvement of the relevant UK notified bodies where stipulated and to meet the requirements thereof.
2. The Contractor shall in particular label machinery which falls under the applicable version at the time in question of the Supply of Machinery (Safety) Regulations 2008 and/or electrical equipment that falls under the applicable version at the time in question of the Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 2016 with a UKCA mark and supply operating instructions for it. The Contractor shall supply the declaration of conformity and the operating instructions to the Client in text form. Incomplete machines are to be supplied to the Client with a declaration of incorporation and detailed installation/operating instructions that take account of the requirements of the Supply of Machinery (Safety) Regulations 2008.
